Covid Guidelines for Boat Fishing (updated January 2022) until further notice.

The permit holder is responsible for compliance by all in his/her party with these guidelines which are provided to ensure Covid safe access.

Anglers fishing on club waters should be familiar with and continue to follow the five principles behind the Scottish Government's FACTS campaign:

- F – wear a Face covering
- A – Avoid crowded places
- C – Clean hands and surfaces regularly
- T – stay Two metre distance away from other people
- **S** – Self-isolate and book a test if you have COVID-19 symptoms (new continuous cough, fever or loss of, or change in, sense of smell or taste)

Anglers are required to always comply with current Covid regulations and guidelines issued by the Scottish Government which take precedence over anything contained in these guidelines. The Club will provide disinfectant surface spray for boat anglers' use in the fishing huts. Anglers and their guests must carry and apply suitable hand sanitiser for their own use to ensure their own safety.

- a) Boats are restricted to a single daily boat turn and must be booked in advance using the Club's online booking system.
- b) Unless from the same household, access to fishing huts is restricted to one person for access to oars and while inside, the door should be left open to increase ventilation.
- c) Surfaces that may have been touched by others (door handles, oars, locks, chains, engines and any parts of the boats likely to be touched etc) should be sanitised before and after use.
- d) Unless from the same household, equipment used (e.g. nets, drogues, oars etc) should not be shared.
